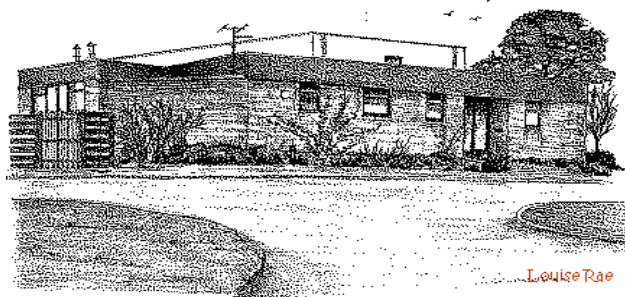

Sport Update

On Tuesday 22nd May 8 of our Y6 children went to Bridport Leisure Centre to compete in the Kwik Cricket Tournament. They all played brilliantly under the captainship of Millie-Jane coming second in the first of their heats. Thomas partnered with Sam scored many runs including quite a few sixes. Unfortunately, we were beaten in the final playoffs but all the children played extremely well and were a credit to the school.

On Tuesday 5th June 16 of our athletes went to Sir John Colfox School, Bridport to take part in the collaboration Quad Kids Competition. The children had to run a 75m sprint, 600m, standing long jump, vortex howler throw and take part in a 400m relay. All the children put a 100% effort into all their events and were a credit to themselves and our school.

The results show that Helena, Poppy and Leighton achieved Bronze Level in the UKA Awards Quadrathlon and Anna achieved Silver Level and in the individual rankings came third overall in the girls. We were proud that our teams came fifth and eighth out of the fourteen teams that took part. Anna received a well-deserved award from the Headteacher of Sir John Colfox. Congratulations to all who took part.

On Friday 25th May 32 children entered the West Dorset Collaboration Swimming Gala at Bridport Leisure Centre. Our children swam magnificently and supported their team brilliantly. A big thank you must go to all the parents that helped poolside and the bronze ambassadors that helped getting the children into the correct lanes ready for their races. We achieved Gold, Silver and Bronze Certificates for individual children's races and Silver for two out of the four relays. This year we came third only narrowly missing out on second place by a couple of points. Well done to all our swimmers.

The website for ordering meals can be found at www.dorset.mealselector.co.uk where you must register before payment can be accepted. You only have to register once; thereafter please use your login details. You can place your order at any time up until the cut off time of midnight on Sunday - 7 days before the full week in which the meal is to be served.

When you register your children on the system, please can we ask that you allocate them to the relevant class as below so that their order will appear on the correct list in school:

Also all Corfe and Chesil children are entitled to free school meals; when you register for the first time, tick the checkbox to apply for eligibility for free school meals. You will need to wait for a confirmation email from Chartwells before you can place the first order and not be charged for the meals.
