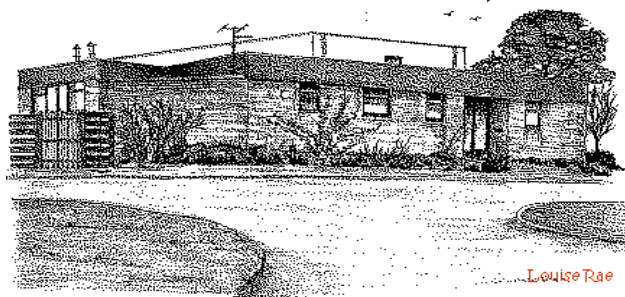

You can place your order at any time up until the cut off time of midnight on Sunday - 7 days before the full week in which the meal is to be served.
