Each day your child needs to bring:

- Their book-bag with their reading book and Reading Record inside

Please ensure all of your children's clothes are clearly labelled with their name to ensure they don't get lost.

### Reading Books

All reading books will be changed by a member of the Chesil staff team to ensure we can track your child's reading progress. Please make sure you let us know if your child needs their book changing, or if you have any queries about their reading, by making a note of this in their Reading Record book. Your child can also now put their book bag in the box to be changed when they come in in the morning.

### Literacy Homework

Reading is without a doubt the most valuable home learning that your child can do and I encourage you to read at least three times a week at home with your child.

Year 2s will start to do spelling tests after October half term and will have their spelling words to practice at home as homework.

Year 1s will have phonics sheets as homework.

### Maths Homework

Both Year 2s and Year 1s will have Prospectus Maths quests as homework starting after half term, and I will give you more information nearer the time.
