Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Dorset Music Service – Musicianship Programme Continuation

Your child may be interested in continuing to learn a musical instrument following on from the whole class instrumental work they are currently receiving. In your child's school we are offering students the opportunity to learn to play the violin for the next two terms at a heavily subsidised cost.

Dorset Music Service will provide your child with an instrument for the duration of the lessons and arrange for a teacher to visit the school (during the school day) to deliver group lessons to those students who have applied for a place.

This work is majority funded by Arts Council England, however there will be a small financial contribution required to enable your child to take part in this work. A terms worth of lessons will cost £30.00 which will include the lessons for the term and instrument hire. This will enable your child to learn as part of a small group for 30 minutes per week. We aim to deliver ten lessons per term, but any missed lessons will not be refunded as the financial contribution is only a fraction of the true delivery costs.

Once we have received the application for your child, we will contact you again to let you know more details about your child's lessons and ask you to make payment for the first term of lessons. Before your child can start lessons, payment must be received by the Dorset Music Service. If your child chooses to continue in to the second term, we will ask for a further payment of £30.00.

For your child to take part in this work, you will need to complete an application form which gives consent for your child to have lessons and forms an agreement between yourself and Dorset Music Service that you will contribute financially towards these lessons and support your child with their musical learning. The application form can be found online or alternatively you can ask your school for a hard copy which you should return to your child's school. **The deadline to complete the application form is Friday 8th November. Late applications will not be accepted.**
