



## **CURRICULUM COMMITTEE - TERMS OF REFERENCE**

For all Committee Meetings a quorum of 3 is required

1. To advise the Governing Body on the School's Curriculum Statement and statutory obligations concerning the National Curriculum.
2. With the assistance of staff, the committee is to be provided with information about how the curriculum is taught, monitored, evaluated and resourced.
3. To review the following statutory policies and make recommendations:
  - Collective Worship;
  - Religious Education;
  - Sex and Relationships Education (S.R.E.)
  - Special Educational Needs and Disability (S.E.N.D.)
4. To ensure that the requirements of the S.E.N.D. Code of Practice are met.
5. To review statutory information about school performance and target setting.
6. To consider, and make recommendations as appropriate on:
  - Personal, Social and Health Education (P.S.H.E.)
  - Community Cohesion and PREVENT
  - Homework
  - Citizenship including the Rights Respecting Schools agenda
  - Other cross-curricular themes including Equality, British Values, Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural development (S.M.S.C.)
  - Inclusion including provision for Gifted and Talented pupils
7. To contribute to the School Development Plan where appropriate.
