Different types of poppies to remember the Great War



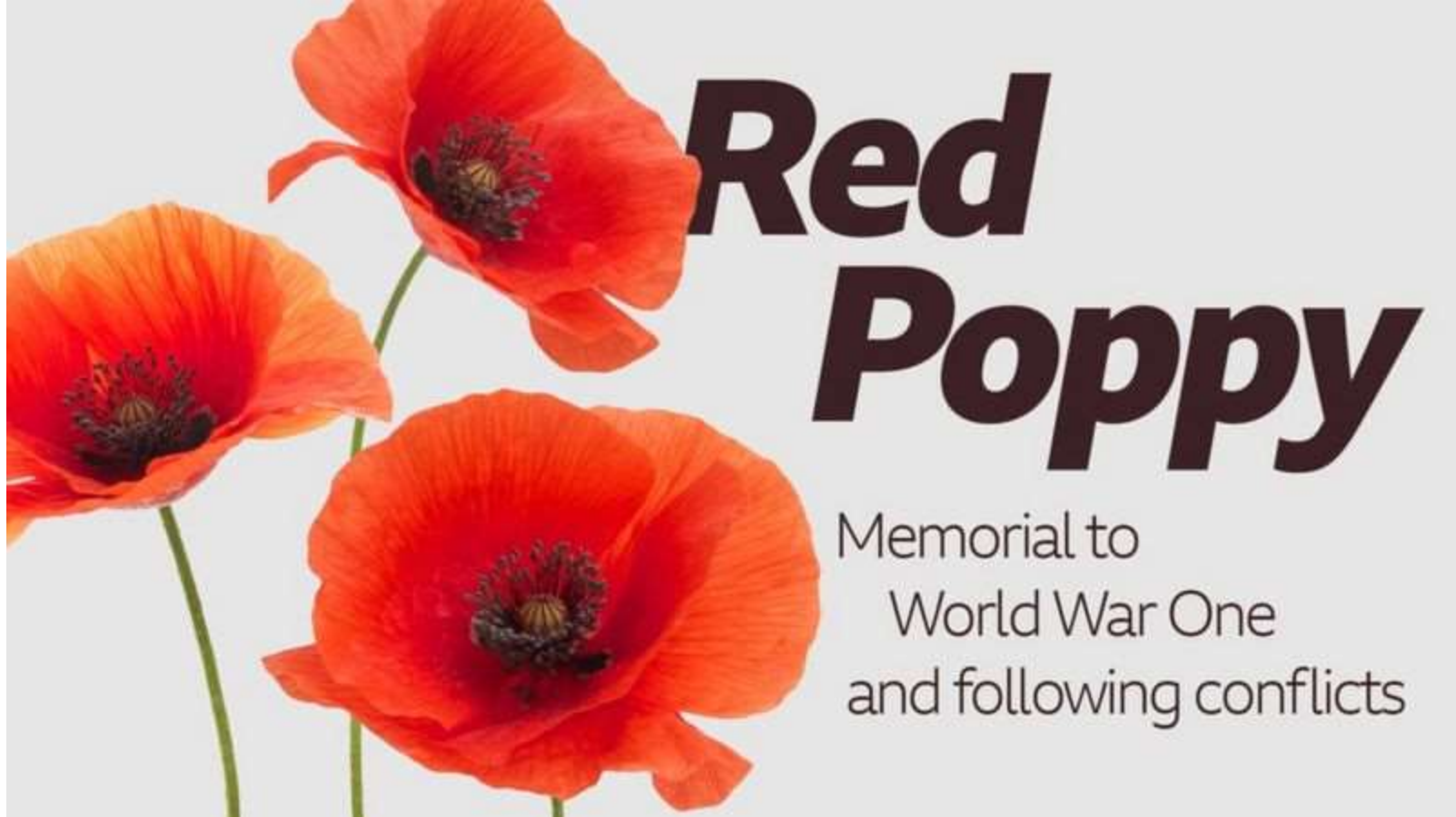
Background on the poppies
