His talent was soon spotted and, at the age of 12, David was offered a scholarship to Kelly College Boarding School to combine his education and sporting commitments. After just 3 years at Kelly College, David qualified for the 2004 Paralympic Games under the tutelage of former Olympian, Robin Brew.

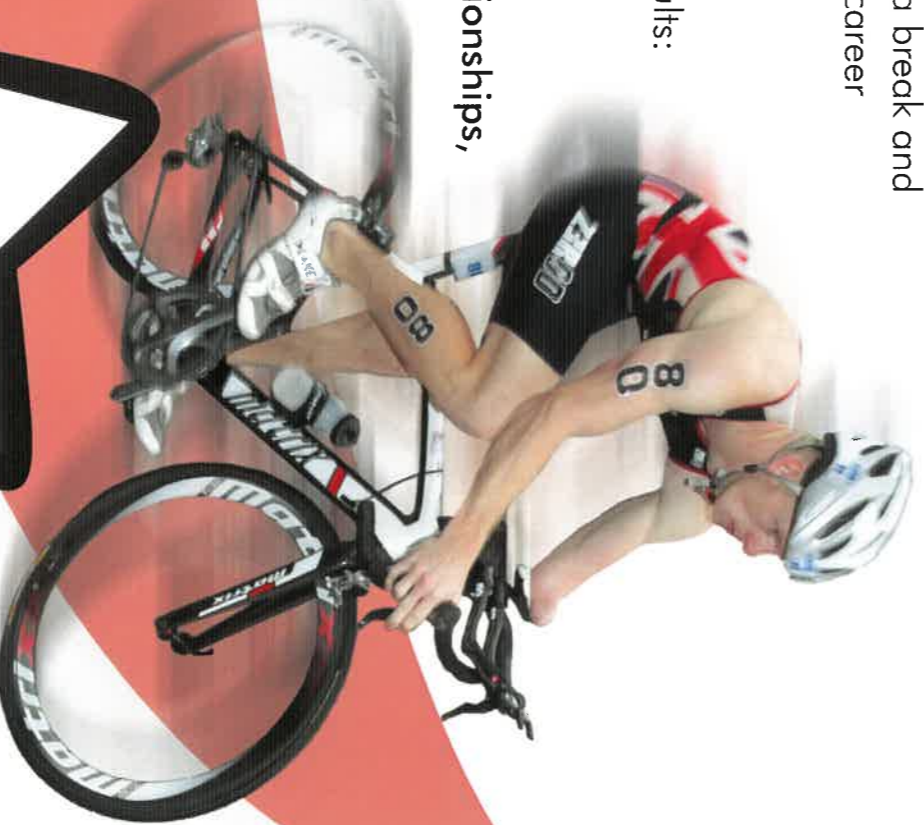
Some of David's swimming career highlights are as follows:

- ★ 2009 European Championships Bronze Medallist
- ★ 2009 World Championships, two Bronze Medals
- ★ 2006 World Championships Silver Medallist
- ★ 2005 / 06 / 07 / 08 - Paralympic World Cup Medallist

After London 2012 David took a break and decided to refocus his sporting career to compete in the triathlon.

In just two years within his new discipline, David has already achieved some outstanding results:

- ★ 2014 World Tri Series, Bronze Medal
